2. Proposed date of the event

Saturday, July 5th – Sunday July 6th, 2025

The proposed dates are contemplated according to a series of factors that condition the celebration of the event, mainly climatic and meteorological. The area has a predominantly continental mountain climate. We have to take into account that two quite large parts of the terrain will be located above 2,000 meters of altitude and it is at this time of the year when the conditions are the most optimal to be traversed for 24 hours. On the other hand, at this time of the year, there are no environmental factors that require special care for the fauna or flora in the area. In this choice, we also take into account the risk of fire, which is still low at this time of the year.



3. Planned Location

The area through which the Rogaine will run belongs to three towns in the southeast of the province of Burgos: Quintanar de la Sierra, Neila and Regumiel de la Sierra, all of them framed in the Sierra de Neila and Sierra de Urbión, belonging to the Iberian System, this mountain range is located in the northern interior of Spain.



The area chosen for the event has sufficient infrastructure to accommodate with solvency both participants and organizers due its large number of hotel rooms spread throughout the region. At the same time, and very important, Quintanar de la Sierra has a campsite and a large capacity campground where you can accommodate all participants. Next to these dependencies there is a recreation area of large dimensions ideal for locating the Competition Center with space to install for a week the infrastructure and services involved in the event: services for the participants, free campsite area, and more than enough space to set up the large Hash House tent.

On the other hand, the region, Burgos and Castilla y León offer many possibilities of all kinds to the visitor: sports, environmental, social, cultural, gastronomic, etc... Good incentives to spend a few days in the area enjoying all this offer.

4. Organizers' experience in participation and organizing rogaines.

The organizers, IbeRogaine, A.D. Tjalve and Corzo Orienteering Club, provide an expert, balanced and enthusiastic team to undertake the event that is the reason for this proposal: WRC2025.

IbeRogaine and its club members organized the 10th and 13th European Rogaining Championship in 2013 and 2016, and the 16th World Rogaining Championship in 2019.

This organizational team chosen for the programming, promotion, management and organization of the 19th WRC2025 is made up of a mix of experienced orienteers and rogainers. The addition of experience of ones and the enthusiasm of others in a perfect combination, will bring a successful championship.



Oscar de la Fuente Alonso.

Event Director

Selected for his management skills as the Event Director of the 19th WRC2025. He has been involved in the organization of a multitude of orienteering events. Highlighting his role as director and cartographer in the national rogaïne -I Trofeo Valle del Arlanza- 2021 and in his future role as director and cartographer in the -II Trofeo Valle del Arlanza- 2023 and in the -III Trofeo Valle del Arlanza- 2024, of 12 Hours valid for the Spanish Championship of Iberogaine.

He is also endorsed by his link with the world of orienteering and mountain biking for many years. An unconditional of the rogaines, he has participated in countless of them throughout his career as an athlete accumulating a wide experience in this discipline.

His ability as a cartographer will make him part of the cartographic team to draw up the map of the event. His profession is draughtsman designer.

Event Co-Director

Organizer of national and international orienteering events (National Leagues and Spanish Championships) both as co-director and setter since 2009.

Orienteering sports technician and extensive experience in international events (World Cup, European Championships, World Championships...). Sportsman of the absolute national team since 2014.

We must also highlight his participation in some rogaines of 8 and 6 hours.

His training as a cartographer will make him part of the cartographic team for the elaboration of the map of the event.

In 1996 and as event director, he organizes the Spanish Mountain Bike Orienteering Championship in Aranda de Duero.

He collaborate with the University and the City Council of Burgos in the development of short courses for children.

He has participated in many different national and regional orienteering leagues, being champion of Spain on several occasions and in different categories.

As president of Tjalve he has organized two National level events in 2012 and 2017, as well as almost every year a Northern League event, relay events, sprints and in 2022 and 2023 Rogaining events of the national calendar.!



5. Terrain.

The competition area will comprise about 200km² and is located in the Iberian System in the inner north of Spain. Specifically it covers part of the summit of the Sierra de Neila and its slopes, both north and south and part of the Sierra de Urbión also with its southern and northern slopes. Its highest peaks are: Campiña 2049m, Muñalba 2073m and Tres Provincias 2056m. 

This mountainous environment offers a physically demanding terrain in which the elevation gain to be covered will be a determining factor or at least quite important. Navigational skills and strategic abilities are of vital importance in approaching and attacking the controls if rogainers are to successfully optimize their races..



Forested areas cover 70% of the map, with pine (*Pinus Sylvestris*) being the main floral protagonist, generally quite passable. The open areas are mainly on the summits and are formed by meadows and some more or less stony areas, relatively passable, located mainly in the glacial cirques formed in both mountain ranges..

The network of roads, forest tracks and trails is quite extensive, allowing good accessibility to the entire map of the competition.

Everything described above together with a multitude of hidden places of singular beauty, spread over many points of the terrain form an extremely unique scenario, with a multitude of possibilities to navigate, and at the same time, enhancing a wide range of strategies, making it a very attractive and irresistible area to compete in this sport discipline..



6. Map

The scale chosen for the mapping will be 1:25,000 or 1:30,000 with an equidistance of 10 meters. The sources to create the map are updated orthophotos of Castilla y León, LIDAR data, Mapant and IGN. Of course, an exhaustive field work will be done to complete a quality map according to the importance of the event.

The elaboration of the map will be done with orientation software, OCAD and OOMapper.

The map will be built from a base map, with an approach fully harmonized with the rogaines' philosophy.

The terrain it covers is completely virgin in the field of rogaining and orienteering, there are no maps of the area and no competitions have been held on this terrain, so no rogainer has an advantage over their opponents in this respect.

The people in charge of elaborating this map are: Oscar de la Fuente, Eduardo Gil and Roberto Pascual.



7. Description of Punching system and Result computing software

Because it is so practical and globally widespread, the SPORTIdent (SI) electronic punching system will be used for time control and scoring.

The initial prevision for the route will be around 80 control points. Therefore, the recommended SI-card model will be SI10 and SIAC.

The software will be SportIdent, Autodownload or similar, always taking in account the specifically roving multi-categories classification.

Each member of the team will have to carry a SI card, which will be sealed on his wristband. SI cards may be rented and will be provided by the organizers.

All teams must carry GPS provided by the organization. Live retransmission will be done with a delayed broadcasting start..



8. Logistics

The organizing team has some material to organize the competition, besides, it counts on collaborators and companies that provide the necessary material and infrastructure for the correct functioning of the tasks involved in the development of the event.

Producciones Salas, S.L., a local company specialized in renting infrastructure for all kinds of shows, will provide tents, catering, furniture, fences, etc.

The Instituto para el Deporte y Juventud IDJ de Diputación de Burgos will provide the start-finish arches, public address system, stage truck, podium, personalized bibs, banners, ribbons, photo call, etc.

dMillennial, a local company, led by Rubén Pérez Pérez, an experienced in international rogaines, will provide the timing, GPS system, speaker, merchandising, etc...

The area chosen to locate the Competition Center has several municipal services, which the town of Quintanar de la Sierra will gladly provide to the organizers to ensure the maximum success of the event: large parking for vehicles of all types, camping area, swimming pools, recreation area... .

The large capacity Arlanza campsite, plus a whole series of hotels and restaurants spread throughout the region will be able to accommodate and serve all visitors comfortably.

We will work programming and coordinating all this so that the WRC becomes a pleasant and unforgettable experience for all participating rogainers, it is our goal and it is our desire that this is so.





9. Weather and climate conditions and Hazards

The area has a predominantly continental mountain climate. The seasons are very marked; winters are usually cold with frosts and snowfalls; summers are warm and dry, mild and not very rainy; springs and autumns are quite rainy. Precipitation is distributed throughout the year, decreasing in summer.

The annual thermal oscillation is around 15° C; the daily oscillation in the extreme cases can exceed 20°C.

In selected dates, the expected temperature will be comprised from 8°-13° to 18°-25°. Other climate conditions could be T-storms, but not so frequents, though due its 800m of altitude range the daily weather varies considerably from one area to another.

There are no relevant hazards, neither flora nor fauna risks. Only mention two viper species, *vipera aspis* and *vipera latasei*, which they are no mortals, only toxics, but the protocol indicates not to run and advise medical emergencies. Anyway, the probability of this risk is very low and unusual

10. Lighting

The dates chosen for the celebration of the event are very close to the summer solstice, so the duration of the day is one of the longest of the year, thus favoring the hours spent with natural light..

11. Transport and Accomodation information

Transport:

The Competition Centre can be reached by vehicle (car, motorhome, own or rental) from various locations in Spain, but the most central and obvious point is from Madrid. The area around Madrid airport offers a wide range of car rental services, so rogainers will have no problem if they choose this option.

Also, it's possible to arrive to Event Center by public transport, by buses or train and bus.

Acces by shuttle bus:

The organisation will provide bus transfer from Madrid airport on request, for those rogainers who have this need or wish to do so. Price will be publish in bulletins.

Acces by air:

There are 3 airports relatively close with international flights:

12. Communication strategies

As an organizational preparation, and at the same time, as a promotion and dissemination of the 19th WRC2025, in September of this same year 2023 Tjalve together with our collaborators we will celebrate a 7-hour rogaine and for 2024 another 12-hour rogaine, the IbeRogaine Championship.

Apart from the above, and with the idea of adding experience and also as a means of dissemination of WRC2025, much of the organizational team will attend the Cto. Iberogaine 2023 in Girona.

On the other hand, the organizers will count on the professional services, before, during and after the event, of the company dMillennial, led by Rubén Pérez Pérez, an experienced rogaier, to create the event website and to provide media as posters, TV, press, social networks, etc. With the purpose of promoting, publicizing and giving the maximum diffusion to the event..
